Telephone Conversation with AFYSIF/1 on 18 August 1965

- 1. On 18 August I talked with ANVAIP/1 on the telephone. He was in his New York office and said that he was very busy. He also was very pleased with the success of his exhibit at a fewelry show earlier this month in New Yorka?
- A/1 said he now plans to leave for Europe about 10 September and to be there for four to six weeks on business.
- 3. We agreed that 4/1 should come to Casnington the afternoon or evening. of 26 August and plan to remain for about twenty-four hours. This timing is to be confirmed by us on 25 August. (he plan to FIUTTER A/1 remains of August and subsequently introduce him to fom Hazlett, if nothing arises in the FIUTER to argue against this course.)
- 4. A/1 indicated that he had no significant news of or from the AMIASH crew.
- 5. A/l expressed concern over the failure of his two aged female relatives ngs in Madrid attempting to get vis- s to the U.S. to join the 4/1 menage. The mother of A/1 is most ugset over the delay. A/1 was informed that the root of the problem is probably the Spanish passivorts held by the ladies and that we are continuing our efforts to see if any way can be found to get around prolonged delays for issuance of visas for those holding opanish passports.
