<p>(4) <u>LIPWAT/Chad</u> LIPWAT coverage in this area has been limited to coverage of the home base of a Chad intelligence officer. Unfortunately, no date listing of operational value has turned up on this line other than the monthly date of interest.</p> <p>(5) <u>LIPWAT/Mali</u> LIPWAT's continuing coverage of POLARD-R has provided information of interest to KUPARK on R-1's planned travel and the delays to that travel as well as his current type and place of employment. Coverage of Judith PERRETO-Squire provided the lead on which the recruitment of LICHTW-1 was based. R-1 was recruited as an access agent to PERRETO for possible future recruitment attempt of her. This coverage has also enabled this station to advise another station of the possible susceptibility to recruitment of a Communist from the country of concern to that station.</p> <p>(6) <u>LIPWAT/PCW</u> In addition to the PERRETO coverage mentioned in paragraph R.A. (5) above, coverage of a member of the PCW Central Committee, Maria CHARA Tijerina has yielded good information on the pro-Chinese/pro-Soviet infiltrating in the PCW as well as target analysis information on various PCW officials.</p> <p>(7) <u>LIPWAT/American Communist Groups in Mexico (ACGM)</u> The information provided to the local ODENVY office from the coverage of David BRUCKER, Charles SMALL (aka SMOLIKOFF) and Ruth and Anna RAPORIT has been evaluated as valuable by that office. It is particularly useful in covering movements of American Leftists and Communists who travel to Mexico and frequently on to Cuba.</p> <p>(8) <u>LIPWAT/Miscellaneous</u> LIPWAT coverage of a former SMOWH agent is of interest to SMOWH, Headquarters and the senior GEMOKS officer in Mexico. This and the coverage of a related line enable the interested customers to maintain a check on the former SMOWH agent's activities which are against the best interest of PERRETO.</p> <p>B. <u>PROCESSING OF TALE</u></p> <p>No change.</p> <p>C. <u>PERSONNEL</u></p> <p>LIPAUD-1 has managed to extend his "commission" as investigator of personnel for the telephone company. See SECURITY section below.</p> <p>During the reporting period special work was provided by Headquarters for the treatment of a child of LIPAUD-5. This work was not available locally and LIPAUD-5 was most grateful for the assistance of his "friends" in obtaining this material.</p> <p>D. <u>LIASON</u></p> <p>No change from previous reports.</p> <p>E. <u>SECURITY</u></p> <p>LIPAUD-1's efforts to extend his invent'ative connection to provide support of the telephone company has proven successful. This is partly because of the access of LIPWAT to a secondary line and the security threat to the LIPWAT line and central man when working on installation, repair or removal of LIPWAT on a day. This latter can not be fully negated since it is now apparent that in his natural habitat LIPAUD-1 can never provide the personnel back up protection to those LIPWAT personnel that he could prior to his assignment. Although the day LIPWAT in a LIPWAT type operation can not be completely eliminated, it is felt that it can be reduced to a workable level.</p> <p>The coverage of the Yugoslav Embassy lines has been assumed by LIPWAT. Therefore LIPWAT will not have to run the particular risk of re-establishing the coverage. It was the necessarily complicated "jump" from one central man to another that alerted the telephone company crew to check the tap line working on this coverage reported in paragraph R.A. of reference.</p>
