(d) Rolando Cubelas. Thirty years of age, approximately, also met him at Havana University, when he was a student at the Medical Faculty, participated actively in the struggle against Batista, taking part in the attempt where Cornel Blanco Rico, Chief of the SIM (Servicio de Inteligencia Militar), of the Batista army, lost his life. Afterwards, he entered clandestinely into the United States through New Orleans, in one of the ships of the "Compañia Naviera Garcia Lines", being a refugee of the United States and living for a long time at New York City and Miami. Later he went to Cuba in an expedition that left from Miami clandestinely, together with 29 Cuban members of the "Directorio Estudiantil Universitario", taking arms and explosives to Cuba. With him were Faure Chaumont, José Fernández Cassio, Luis Blanca, the Mago Robreño, Jimenito, Julio el Grande, Pepín Baranjo, William Morgan, Dr. Armando Fleites and some others, reaching Cayo Anguila and exchanging ships, reaching Cuba in fishing boats by the coast of Camaguey. All the group and equipment went by trucks to the city of Camaguey where they were divided into two groups, one commanded by Faure Chaumont was going to Havana with part of the armament, and the other group commanded by Rolando Cubelas and William Morgan was heading towards the mountains of the Escambray on las Villas Province, to join the guerrillas who were commanded by Gutierrez Menoyo. Later on he participated in the taking of the City of Santa Clara together with the troops commanded by Ernesto "Che" Guevara. With the downfall of the Batista regime, he reached the grade of Commandant but without any position of the Government, having already had some disagreement with Fidel Castro who was the leader of 26 de Julio Movement and not wanting to be in disapproval with the government of Castro, left for Spain. When he returned he accepted the position of Subsecretario of the Ministerio de Gobernación of which José (Pepín) Baranjo was Minister. Afterwards he was elected President of the Federación Estudiantil Universitaria, under the orders of Fidel Castro and introduced to the University the armed militias of the government that turned out to be the "tropas de choque" that were used to quiet down the students who protested against the leftist measures of the government towards the establishment of the Communist system at the University.
