1. Although Subject is being detained in PEPRIME at an ODURIE installation, GUTIERREZ Menoyo is being interrogated by representatives of ODENVY. Attached are copies of the results of such interviews which took place on 14, 15 and 16 February 1961. (ODENVY documents dated 17 February and 10 March 1961, respectively) As will be noted above, if the Madrid Station desires to pass the information therein to QUANTUM (see reference), it should be cleared first through the Legal Attache at HRFINCH. Because there is the probability that Subject may be under detention until the present Cuban situation dissolves itself, there undoubtedly will be further interrogations performed, the results of which will be forwarded as received.

2. This desk is in receipt of a report from KUJUMP dated 14 April 1961 which concerns Subject. The source of this information is a Cuban national and a courier who came to PEPRIME as an exile. An extract of the data is as follows: (FOR STATION INFORMATION ONLY).

Prior to his execution, a Major Jesus CARRERAS advised the Catholic Chaplain of La Cabana (Cuba) that his former comrade, Major Eloy GUTIERREZ Menoyo, transported six tons of weapons and explosives to Spain sometime during 1960. This equipment was cached by GUTIERREZ in caves and tombs in the mountains of Asturias in Northern Spain. An individual by the name of Antonio SANZ, now residing in San Sebastian having been deported from Cuba recently, is cognizant of GUTIERREZ' plans. SANZ, a Spaniard, was in prison in Cuba for several months for his alleged participation in a plot to assassinate the Soviet Ambassador to Cuba.
