In early November 1963, Source learned that Jose Ignacio RASCO Bernadez, founder of the Christian-Democrat Movement of Cuba and exile leader, is experiencing financial difficulties and at present employed as a manual laborer. Based on Subject's Source and, his writing and speaking ability, and his teaching experience, Source suggests that Subject may be of value to OIXORR.</p> <p>2. Station personnel recall that Subject was active in Cuban exile activities and is well known to ZUBARK.
