Dear Mr. Secretary:

Since October 1962, when your late beloved President John F. Kennedy courageously quarantined Cuba to defend this hemisphere in the face of a direct threat to it from Soviet ballistic missiles, UNIDAD REVOLUCICMARIA has devoted a good deal of its efforts to belstering the ztrong and clear attitude expressed by the U.S. Government thereby.
