Subject: Report on Cuban Sugar Production of the Consolidated Sugar  
Enterprise, Dept. of Production, Report No. 27, 21 June.

1. At my meeting with Dr. Miro Cardona, 19 July he brought me the attached Report No. 27, dated 21 June, showing Cuban Sugar Production by provinces and the different centrals in each province.

2. Page 8 of the report gives a summary by Provinces as in previous reports that have been received and forwarded. Total production to date of the 1962 harvest is shown to be 4,811,781 metric tons, or 4,669, 818 Spanish long tons.

3. Dr. Miro remarks that this must reflect about the end of the 1962 harvest and therefore the total production for the year.
