MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

SUBJECT: General: Debriefing Report #126 of AMHUG/1
Specific: Identification of Cuban Passports
And Other Photographs

Source identified the photographs of subjects and gave the following comments:

ALARCON Fonseca, Cesar

AMHUG identified ALARCON as the Captain of the plane on the Havana-Canada flight in which AMHUG traveled and subsequently defected. 21 April 1964

GAVILAN Rosales, Esther

AMHUG identified subject as the wife of Rogelio RODRIGUEZ, a DGI officer stationed in the Cuban Embassy in Mexico City.

INTERIAN Cosenzanas, Elpidio

AMHUG identified subject as possibly being the man responsible for the codes in the Cuban Embassy in Mexico City. AMHUG commented that when he was in Mexico City in March 1964, he had seen subject in the Embassy. In addition, he commented that one day he went to the Embassy to see Rogelio RODRIGUEZ. He went to the second floor of the Embassy and knocked on a door. INTERIAN answered. Source said that Rogelio, INTERIAN and the Cuban Consul were having a conference. (LITANIL/9) identified INTERIAN and said that possibly this man had the codes in the Embassy.)

MILAN Olivera, Irma

AMMUG identified the subject as the wife of Andres ARMONA Ramos but he did not give any other information.

OIZ Folguevoiro, Mario

AMMUG identified OIZ as a diplomatic courier. OIZ traveled on the same flight with AMMUG from Havana to Mexico in March 1964.

PEREIRA Vasquez, Raul

AMMUG identified PEREIRA as a servant in the Cuban Embassy in Mexico City. AMMUG saw subject when he was in Mexico in March 1964.

RELOVA Penichet, Osvaldo
aka: "Wilberto"

AMMUG has given us data on this subject. He identified the photograph.

REBELLON Alonzo, Jose

AMMUG identified REBELLON as the President of the UNIVERSITY STUDENT FEDERATION (Federacion Estudiantil Universitaria, FEU). AMMUG commented that he had seen REBELLON at Pineiro's house several times.

YASELLS Gonzalez, Augustin

AMMUG identified subject as a diplomatic courier. YASELLS traveled with AMMUG on the flight from Havana to Mexico in March 1964.
