A. PIERRE LELIO HUDICOURT BORN 23 JUNE 1912, JEREMIV, HAIYI. EXTREMELY WELL-EDUCATED, WRITER, LAWYER AND DIPLOMAT. RECENTLY REPORTED AS COMPLETED ALCOHOLIC. SPEAKS FLUENT FRENCH, ENGLISH AND SOME SPANISH.

B. HAS HELD DIPLOMATIC POSTS (1941-1959) IN DOMINICAN REPUBLIC, CHILE, ECUADOR, COLOMBIA, PANAMA, AND VENEZUELA. VETERAN OF NUMEROUS INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCES INCLUDING ECLA (1948-53) AND PAD (1949); WAS DELEGATE TO SEVENTH, EIGHTH AND NINTH UN GENERAL ASSEMBLY.

C. REPORTED TO BE MEMBER OF NOW DEFUNCT LEFTIST POPULAR SOCIALIST PARTY (PSP), WHICH ORGANIZED BY HIS BROTHER, MAX IN 1946 AND LATER ALIGNED WITH CUBANS. MAX WAS COMMITTED SUICIDE APRIL 1947. WAS LEADER OF PARTY IN HAIYI. PIERRE EXTREMELY SENSITIVE
