SUBJECT: Assassination of President Kennedy

- 1. An untested ocures recently furnished as with the following information he Allogedly received from a wall-depoint Cuban extention and acquaintance on 23 November 1963, but which he had forgotten to report. The release of the Warren Commission Report on the normalization reminded him of the intident.
- 2. The occeptist said that by chance he had been at the Havens eirport on the afternoon of 22 November 1963 when at 1700 hours an aircraft with Mexican markings landed and partied at the far side of the Rold. Two men, whom he recognized as Cubin "gangatore," Michiel. entered the rear entrance of the administration building and disappeared without going through the normal customs procedures. His surjuster. was areased, and he was this to learn that the aircraft had just arrived, from Dallas, Texas, via Tijetus and Mexico City. The plans had be forced to land at Tijunes due to aggine trouble. By combining the date, the origin of the flight, and the known reputation of the two men, he theorized that the two men must have been involved comehow in the assassination of Prosident Konnedy: He speculated that Lee Harvey OSWALD had acted in the pay of GASTRO, and that the two Cubene had been in Dallas to organize or oversee the operation. He told the source that he had been greatly distressed by what he had seen and heard and had to tell comeons about it. He then cautiqued course not to tell aurens else about it, or they would both be shot by the Cabbas.
- 3. The cource has passed away since furnishing the above information, thus making any follow-up on this matter impossible.
