Subj, also known as Frank Fiorini, and Bill Johnson, recently returned to Miami from Cuba on their boat VIOLIN after putting ashore in Cuba on 26 Feb three Cuban exiles.

Meeting at 2000 S.W. 1st Ave. Miami, Fla. on 20 April 1960... military group. Frank Fiorini appeared to be the leader of the group. Group was supposed to have 6 B-26's, a B-25, 2 P-51's. It was further stated that there were some aircraft in South America ready to go. FIORINI made the remark that this particular group would not be using the airplanes with the implication that another group would take over the movement of the listed aircraft. The group as a whole was to be known as the "Crusaders" and there was talk of having a cross-type insignia made. Fiorini claimed to have recruited seven Canadians and 33 U.S. citizens with previous military experience who were supposed to be the military leaders of additional forces as they were recruited. The group intended to operate a radio station in the mountains for propaganda purposes. Fiorini gave the impression that the expedition could leave anytime within the next three or four weeks from the Florida area. Uniforms and arms have been acquired for a force of about 50 men.

Subj's true identity of subject contracted several U. of Miami students radio "Duro" in attempt to have them assist in setting up comm. on a yacht and also to train others in operation and maintenance of radio equipment.

Subj's pilot's certificate of license of citizenship to subject. Photo taken in 1955, shows subject as Cuban citizen, radio available to subject. Subj's activities in anti-CASTRO group for purpose of dropping leaflets 21 Oct 59.

Subj's pilot's certificate has been revoked by FAA and his appeal of the order expatriating him is still pending. One source stated subj has been assisting in anti-CASTRO matters recently, and another source said subj had a misunderstanding with Pedro DIAZ Lans. Said subj has not discussed his activities with him but did say recently there are too many groups and ideas working against CASTRO.

According to Nell Macaulay, who talked with subj and Pedro DIAZ Lans, Subj trying to talk Diaz Lans into allowing him to take 50 men and attack Cuba. (talk took place sometime after 24 July 1960)

Inquiry indicates subj's only activities in anti-CASTRO matters are in conjunction with defected former head of Cuban FAR, Pedro DIAZ Lans. One source said he believed subj's activities are for financial and not ideological reasons. Another indicated subj is having financial difficulties. Subj's expatriation case reopened on technicalities and will be set for hearing in Miami in near future.

Subj says he was on board a B-25 airplane that dropped some 500,000 leaflets over Camaguey Province, Cuba, on 23 Oct 1961. (DEF-93370, 27 Oct 1961)

Robert Frank Swanner arrested in Nassau for break of air navigation rules and smuggling. Articles smuggled were 200 lbs anti-Castro pamphlets for Cuba drop. Three other US citizens involved: William J. Johnson, Alexander Bourke, and subj. Smuggling charges not being pressed. (Admission, Nassau, Bahama, 11 Dec 61)

Subj claims he is under orders of Raul Castro and is awaiting orders to begin training 1,000 members of militia in SACU area.

Subj is in charge of a separation center, training camp and staging area in SACU area.

Subj claims to be awaiting repair of aircraft that Pedro DIAZ Lans and he will fly under the direction of Allen Dulles and/or CIA. Cited DEF gives names of different groups that subj and DIAZ supposedly belong to, etc.

Subj involved w/Alfredo HERNANDEZ who gave subj's telephone number where he could be reached. HERNANDEZ said that he & 5 other Cubans & 15 Americans were leaving 16 Dec 1960 by boat or plane to travel to Cuba to fight against CASTRO. Group preparing for invasion, in subj's home.

Subj still friendly and associating with Pedro DIAZ Lans. (Answer to query from Hqs in UFGW 252, 13 Feb 61).

William C. Rigold BKA furnished a letter received 14 Jan 61, from a friend who was a member of a counter-revolutionary force under the leadership of subj (FIORINI). The group called "Brigada Internacionalista." The return address on the envelope was: Bob ROSTALLON, 2080 SW 60th Ct., Miami, Fla. (DEF-67322, 24 Jan 61, Seattle)

Subj claimed to be a member of the anti-CASTRO group FRD. Subj had camp 40 miles from Miami with Max VILA Jr. in charge. Camp site deserted as of 31 Jan 1961. On 4 Feb 1961 a tugboat "Bill Roke" was stolen from Miami by group, some of whom were later arrested, and who had previously stayed at subj's Miami residence. Source reported subj on 26 Feb 61 had returned from what he described as unsuccessful attempt to get into Cuba on an invasion. Newspapers reported subj's US citizenship restored after he made appeal to INS. Some of thieves were: Alex Burke, Bob Rostallon, Dick Matley. Also a Ken Proctor was among involved. Subj in July of 61 stated he headed an organization known as the International Anti-Communist Brigade claiming a membership of 5,000 men. Reliable source said this hog wash with subj the only member, and that it is nothing but a paper organ. (Source DEF 46463, 17 Aug 61, 201-242256)

Frank Fiorini has offered his services to Carlos PRIO Socarras as a military advisor and planner for some future armed operation in Cuba. PRIO and subj were observed one day in Sept studying some maps of Cuba. Source believes subj is employed by PRIO. (Army Intel Report ID R/62,837, 9 Oct 1961)

FIORINI, Frank

A twin engined plane dropped food, medicines and anti-Castro pamphlets into a remote area of western Cuba's Pinar Del Rio Province early yesterday, it was reported today. The food, apparently intended for forces of Premier Fidel Castro, was dropped at an unspecified spot. The leaflets fell on the villages of Cortes, Las Martinas and El Cayuyo. A fighter plane from the San Julian Air Base tried to intercept the "invader" but was unable to do so. The flight was arranged by a Cuban refugee group headed by Subject, an ex-U.S. paratrooper in WW II. (FBIS, 15 August 1962)

Subj said he 1st met the Venezuelan thru Allen MacDonald, an American pilot who worked with 26 of July Movement in its pre-Communists days. Subj said that although he does not intend to become involved he promised the Venezuelan he would see what he could do.
