1. A RECENT AS YET UNRESOLVED CASE STUDY INDICATES AELINNET ONE CONTACT WITH AIS MAY BE COMPROMISED TO RIS. NO ACTIVE OP USE OF SUBJ SHOULD BE CONSIDERED TIL ABOVE IS RESOLVED. TO PROTECT SUBJ COVER ONLY SOCIAL CONTACT BETWEEN HIM AND THE CREW WOULD BE PERMISSIBLE, THEREFORE WE SEE NO VALUE FOR SUBJ TRIP TO COPE.

2. HOPE TO ~~CLARIFY~~ ~~RESOLVE~~ POSSIBLE COMPROMISE WHICH NO FAULT

OF BERN OR SUBJ BY END SUMMER 63. ID MEANTIME SEE NO NEED CHANGE PATTERN CONTACT WITH SUBJ IF POURSUED WITH NORMAL PRECAUTIONS
