JAGUAR has forwarded us the attached press cuttings by or about <u>Jonathan Power</u>, whose name has cropped up from time to time in our MECHAOS reporting. <u>Jonathan Richard Adrian Power</u> was born 4 June 1941 in the UK and carries a British passport No. D430314, renewed 21 July 1969. He is a journalist who has written for a number of publications and has been associated with television, but claims employment with the <u>Economist</u>. JAGUAR's only other comment was that [REDACTED] [REDACTED] on the Hazlemere Group (subject of previous reporting) stated in June 1969 that Power spoke of Cuba in a way which suggested that he had visited there.</p> <p>2.
