1. During Brigitte F. WASSERLAUF's visit in Earch 1966, she mentioned Subject to the JACUAN analyst assigned to Second Chief Directorate activities. The latter has now written a summary of information from JACUAN files on Subject and attached three photographs of Subject which are transmitted herewith.

"When (WASSERLAUF) was here last Earch, one of the INdex cards which she looked at was for SHIRAMOVA. Since then I have discovered that SHIRAMOVA figures in the Warren Report as the Intourist guide provided for Lee CEMALD on his aurival in Escov in October 1959. Our information about her is briefly as follows:

"SHIRAMOVA has come to our notice as the friend of two British brothers who first visited the Soviet Union in 1960. She and a male guide joined the party with which the brothers were travelling at the Russian border. One of the brothers, who has pursued the friendship more than the other, considers he made the running, not CHERAMOVA. He claims that relations between them have become affectionate, but are platomic. In fact since he first met SMIRAMOVA she has married and had a child, and our source visits their home when he goes to the Soviet Union. They also maintain a steady correspondence.

"After the birth of her daughter in October 1836, 1465 SHIPAHOVA, now Hrs. SHIWATOK, wrote that she had left intedrast and was employed as a teacher of English in a Loscow teachers' training college.

"The two brothers last visited the ZHITIDOKS at their home in a new housing estate in Moccou in August 1985. One of the things Rima showed them was an album of coloured postcards of places in the U.S.A. which she claimed had been sent her by an American in return for money she had lent him when he was visiting the Soviet Union and ran short of funds. Unfortunately our source was not able to discover the name of the American or anything about him.
