4. TeresaXPROENZA told [19] that Mirta AGUIRRE, Cuban intellectual, became disgusted with the Consejo Nacional de Cultura and left to teach at the Universidad de Habana. FROENZA and this during a conversation with [19] re advisability of working in Cuba. PROENZA and [29] both agreed that they would not want to work in Cuba. PROENZA gave [19] the idea that she might be going to Paris. [19] believes that Coty SOLCRZANO might have brought this word back to PROENZA from Habana.

5. On 11 June 63, Horacio FLORES Sanchez told [10] that he had arranged to send a Mexican Art exhibit to Cuba. [10] said that PROENZA had previously reported this. [10] described FLORES as "un demonio" and has always referred to him as a dangerous anti-U.S. type.

- 6. PROENZA told [1-9] that Ramon XSINORAS told Coty SOLORZANO that [1-9] was doing a terrific job etc. SINORAS has been extremely nice to [1-9] since his return from Habana.
- 7. [1-9] said he has noted an obvious coldness on the part of henuel VEGA Perez, Chief Cuban G-2 in Mexico. He said he hardly says hello. [1-9] believes it possible that "Conchita" FERNANDEZ said something to him in Habana re his remark several months ago re [1-9's] plane wide with ANLEO 3's pilot. [1-9] said he told FERNANDEZ about this remark when he was in Habana the last time. [1-9] plans to appraoch VEGA and if he reacts coldly he will ask him what is bothering him.

2. $[L^{Ol}]$ said that on 27 May 1963, Ramon SINOBAS Casado, Cuban Charge, gave him a list of names received from Habana re applications for employment in Cuba. SINOBAS told $[L^{Ol}]$ to investigate the names and to bear in mind that their political ideology is of utmost importance. $[L^{Ol}]$ was amazed that SINOBAS gave him this task as it appears to fall into Manuel VEGA's bailwick, i.e. G-2. $[L^{Ol}]$ plans to take advantage of this task to find out about their friends, etc. The names are as follows: Mauro FERNANDEZ Ugalde, Alfredo NEVER Avila, Eduardo OLIVERA, Victor M. RUIZ, Mexicans and Eduardo PINTOS Mimo, Spaniard.

NOTE: FERNANDEZ was previously reported by $L^{\underline{O}}9$ to be a close friend of Ma. Teresa PROENZA P., who has helped him re education. See previous memo re same. The report from Habana provides biog data which $L^{\underline{O}}9$ will provide on night of 31 May 1963.
