According to Ramon Sinobas Casado, Charge D'Affaires of the Cuban Embassy in Mexico City, as of 17 June 1963 about 20 Mexican architects had accepted invitations to attend the Seventh Congress of the International Union of Architects scheduled to take place in Habana from 28 September to 3 October 1963.
- 2. Teresa Proenza Proenza, Cultural Attache of the Cuban Embassy in Mexico City, placed an announcement about the congress in the 12 June issue of Siempre, Mexican leftist, semi-monthly magazine, through Fernando Benitez Gutierrez, pro-Communist journalist, and frequent contact of the Cuban Embassy.

Field Comment. According to the article in Siempre, the theme of the congress will be "Architecture in Countries on the Road to Development."
