HMM-26414 22 June 1965 Details of the L Pulse Camera Operation

Lew H. meets on average of 2 times week to get negatives. ..since the installation, Glenn W, ~~MM~~ at the NOC site, has had to repair. PC operates 6 hrs/day. 5 days/week....production sent to Miami for A-1.

Simple fact: The 27S63 installation report said that all testing of the system would be forwarded to Hq when available.

It was sent as attachemtn to 7N63. LHO is not in it.

The TM252572 refers to negatives from the pulse camera. These would have been from the Dec. 64 installation...since that system yielded only negatives..per the June 65 report.
