1. STATION HAS MET WITH [] AND [] TO CONSIDER REF. STATION BELIEVES THIS METHOD OF OBTAINING LICOAX SUPPORT TELEGRAMS IS OVER COMPLICATED AND UNLIKELY PRODUCE RESULTS AS SOON AS NEEDED WHICH IS IN NEXT FOUR DAYS. FURTHERMORE STATION NOW AT VERY DELICATE POINT IN LONGPLANNED MERGER BETWEEN LICOAX AND ZR(FRAID) AND REFERENCE PROCEDURE WOULD BE IRRITANT IN SMOOTHLY PROCEEDING MOVEMENT, AS WELL AS DEFINITE SECURITY PROBLEM.
