- 1. On 23 May 1962 Anastacio de la "Gerra telephoned the Chill installation and requested an interview with the CDENTY representative. Se was told at that time that no ODENTY representative was located in Manterrey but was given the mans of an officer in ODACID (actually the CDENTY representative) with when he might discuss his problem. Subject said that he was mainly interested in obtaining employment with KDRARK. At the time of this conversation, the Subject said that he was Maniega born and was now a naturalized U.S. citizen using the name Randel E. Fitzpatrick. - 3. On 12 July 1963 Subject came personally to the (DEACID installation and asked the local receptionist if he could talk with the EUBARK installation.
