tecurity files reflect that the subjects of the attached memoranda are additional American citizens who have defected to the Soviets or their Satellites during the past eighteen months.

Several of the above referred to delectors have been of interest to CIA:

Hornert Lee NORTHRUP, 48923, was a stail employee of this Agency from May 1951 to May 1959. A more detailed summary than that included in the attached group has been propered on him.

Robert Edward WEBSTER, EE-18852, and Nicholas PETRULLI, EE-19439, were subjected OO/C requests on 29 May 1959 and 15 June 1939, respectively, with a view to their being debrisfed upon their returns from visits to Russia. Neither was interviewed by CIA, either before or after their visits.

With reference to Nicholas PETRULLI, it is noted that his cousin,

Tindimir SLOBODA is currently of interest to Security in view of his assignment (prior to his defection to the Seviet Union, via Sant Germany, on 3 August 1769) to the 513th Military Intelligence Croup in Frankfart, Germany, (EGIS Conter). Here he had contact with at loast one representative of CIA and was in 2 position to have learned the identities of CIA personnel at the EGIS Center.

Edward NIXON on a September 1969, approached a CIA agent in Freshy's Bar in Damascue and engaged him in conversation, following which our agent found himself under curveillance. The surveillance continued for two days, after which our agent was approached in Freddy's Bar by an unknown G-2 officer who asked him about NIXON; and thereafter the surveillance ceased. (The owner of Freddy's Bar had reported NIXON to G-2, as he said he was raining his business.)
