1. Attached you will find a security violation report prepared by a representative of the Office of Security, Physical Security Division, concerning exposed classified materials found by a GSA guard on the evening of 22 April 1960.

2. We have discussed the aforementioned violation with Miss [redacted] the custodian of the documents and Mr. Phillips the WH/4 Staff duty officer, and have pointed out the need for greater vigilance and personal security. Inasmuch as Miss [redacted] and Mr. Phillips have had no previous violations, it is recommended that no further action be taken in this matter.
