There is no evidence in the files or the file of the source, Enrique Rugonio Abascal (y Berenguer), #739643, that this information was processed out of the Office of Security/Security Research Staff, to which reported the information. However, as states in the report: "I urged Abascal to go to the FBI with the information, and offered to arrange a meeting. He promised to tell them the story, and made contact through an agent (O'Brien) whom he knew because of past activities."

Regarding Abascal, his Office of Security file contains the following concerning his veracity:

Office of Security/Security Research Staff memorandum dated 15 August 1966: "Abascal has for several years furnished information to SES source which has been proven to be utterly worthless and usually fictitious."

Office of Security/Security Research Staff memorandum dated 19 Hay 1965: "(Abascal) has furnished source with intelligence information which appears to be complete fabrication."

FMI letterhead memorandum dated
30 September 1963 captioned "Movimiento
Democrata Cristiano (MDC)" contains the
following statements about Abascal by
FMI sources: "One would only have to
know Enrique Abascal to know that this,
(a Life magazine article) was nothing
but a publicity stunt on his part and
that he has no importance whatsoever in
the anti-Castro Movement." "Sometimes
in dealing with Abascal, one does not
know whether or not he should pity him
or try to afford him some king of medical
assistance." "Abascal is morely a publicity seaker."

It is apparent the Office of Security/ Security Research Staff had reason to question the veracity of Abascal precluding further dissemination of the information; and that there was a reason to believe that Abascal would report the information to the FBI for their action.

Arlington House, Publishers

The files contain a raw, unevaluated report from containing his reporting of an allegation that CIA had partial control of, and once attempted full control of, Arlington Nouse, Publishers.

(Attached to instant memorandum, Tab B, is a copy of _____ original report as well as copies of attendant decuments. The files centain no further clarification of the information.)

There is no Office of Security subject file in the name of Arlington House or Arlington House, Publishers.

From other sources, it would appear that Arlington Bouse, Publishers is connected with the conservative causes of William F. Buckley and the Mational Roview. Enckley is a former Agency employee and his close connections with former Agency employee B. Heward Bunt have recently received extensive publicity. It is believed that numerous former Agency employees are linked with Buckley's causes, and this could be the foundation for the rumored Agency lavelyement in Arlington House.
