- 1. On 9 February 1985, AMMUG/1 identified a photograph of Luisa RODRIGUEZ Calderon, who he stated had been connected with the DGI (Directorio General de Inteligencia) and the former Secretary of the Young Communists in the Cuban Ministry of Exterior Commerce.

  According to AVIMUGAN the Cuban Government thought RODRIGUEZ had been regruited by the United States Government with an Mexico so shawas recalled to Cuba. AMMUG/10 has not sure a Charles but recalled someth concerning har having reserved a letter from an American Eurther AMMUG/10 has not sure and a comment of the Com defails but recalled something alved a letter from an American.
