-- and a contact of mine in the LIRUM Project -- told me that on April 1962 he saw a man driving a Ford 200 (Black, 1962), license 25-48-02, at 1845 hours, stop in front of the Soviet Embassy and let a passenger out.

- 2. The passenger, 40 years old, medium height, blonde, wearing a grey suit, went inside the Soviet Embassy. The car waited. The driver appeared to be 35 years old, moustache, long oval face, medium-dark complexion.
- 3. On 11 May 1962 OGBURN saw this same car at about 1800 hours parked to the side of the Soviet Embassy.
- 4. ACTION: Identify owner of car: See if we can identify driver and visitor.
