Subject: Iden A

Subject was interviewed and tested on 16 April 1964 at a safe sitg in the Minni area at the request of Henry P. 7 REDISOLTA The interview was conducted in English.

Subject has been involved with KUBANK since 1959. For a period previous to that time Subject was cooperating with ODENVY in Cuba. He is currently being used by PV as a source of information on the Cuban exile community. The excuse for testing Subject was that he was being considered for training. The actual purpose of the interview was to resolve issues raised by JAWAVE/EUDESK which are detailed in VAVE 2672, dated 26 February 1964.

RESULTS

Subject has worked only for KURAKK and ODENTY He has never ecoparated in any way with any intelligence service of any other country. He has never been asked to cooperate with any communist controlled intelligence service. He does not make intelligence type reports to any one other than ADYONE / Subject has no claudestine communication with anyone outside PRFRIME. He is not in evaluat with anyone whom he suspects of being a Caban agent. He has never taken part in any communist activity.

BILATED

Subject stated that it is widely known among the Cuban exile ecomomity that he is in teach with KUBARK? The fact that this is known is partly what emables him to obtain information which is of interest to KUBARK? Subject stated that no more than four or five Americans know of bis/involvement with KUBARK. Among them is Ideu B.

Subject was asked whether he communicated in any way with individuals living outside of PRFKIMT He stated that the enly individual in that entegery was a former Cuban CTC member by the meno of Idea C who presently works for the Alliance for Fragress. iden C is now believed to be in Henduras. Subject stated that him wife Communicator with her family in Cuba but Subject stated that he is positive she does not discuss any of his activities im these ommunications.


Subject stated that his wife is fully knowledgeable of/his KUBARK activities. 7

Subject was asked whether he had any agreement to cooperate with any of the exile erganisations. He stated that in the fermal sense of the yerd he had no such agreement but that he was idealegically emmitted to AHHIUWY/1/and the AHVOKLD forganization. Subject stated

that he has not had any contact with AUBIDDY/1 since he was told to sever his connection in February 1983. He does, however, occasionally see MESA and BARRO. From his remarks it is quite obvious that Subject has a great deal of affection and respect for [AMBIDDY/1.7] Subject stated that he has done nothing recently to actively support the [AMBORLD] group but that he would not hesitate to tell anyone, if they asked, that he felt [AMBORLD] was worthy of all the support that the inquirer could give.

Subject stated that he also has a great deal of respect for the 30th of Nevember Mevement. His contact with that group is Idea D. Subject has only known Idea D for about two nonths and that incidentally was the reason why Idea D's name does not appear on the list of Subject's contacts given to the Station in 1944.

In a discussion of whether or not Subject discusses KURARK business with unauthorized persons, Subject stated that he did not believe he was privy to what might be considered classified information bearing on KURAKE activities. He pointed out that his information gathering activities necessitate a certain amount of give and take which involves bringing information to the attention of certain individuals in order to check their reaction to that information. Subject has not made any deliberate effort to obtain information regarding KURARE notivities from his contacts using the Cuban groups who were for KURARE.

In the discussion of blackmail potentialities Subject stated that he had once been intimate with the wife of Idea E. He stated that as far as he knows Idea E is not aware of this, but that Idea E ence told him that he had compiled derogatory information regarding Subject and forwarded it to AUBARK officials.


Subject stated that he knows at least the following AUBARKers by true mans: Iden P. Iden G. Iden H. and Iden I.

Subject stated that he might recall others if he heard the mames. Subject does not know the name or location of the KURARK base in Miami.

Subject stated that he has always felt that KUBAHK has cen- decidered him a Cubam rather than an American. He wished to make it very clear that he does not consider himself a Cubam but on the centrary considers himself an American.

Subject stated that he felt that AUDARK was not utilizing him to the fullest extent of his abilities. He stated that he desired to become in permanent KUBARK asset and that he would like very much to be utilized, after the appropriate training, in the PM field.
