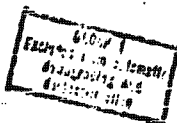
A trained observer with access to a wide variety of Cuban exiles, source is known to most of his contacts as a channel to U.S. intelligence. This information was obtained from an officer of the new organization.

1. A new organization, the Junta de Gobierno de Cuba in el Exilio (JGCE, Junta of the Government of Cuba in Exile), has been created on the basis of contacts between exile leaders and American business firms. Offices have been opened at 113 SW 8th St., Miami, and the following persons are officers of the organization:

2. The JGCE was advanced \$650,000 for its organization and for maintenance costs. Operational funds are expected to be advanced on projects approved by a group of American firms backing the JGCE. Military operations are to be staged in Central America through contacts arranged by representatives of the United Fruit Company, one of the sponsoring firms.
3. One of the first undertakings of the organization will be to station ten men in each Latin American country and delegations in other foreign nations. In each of the ten-man delegations there are to be three labor specialists.

Source Comment

1. Rodriguez is still head of one faction of the 30 November group which had recently been named the Organizacion Frank Pais.
2. Rodriguez is a former Rebel Army captain who had been in asylum in the Uruguayan Embassy in Havana.
