After considerable conversation with Bernie Reichbardt in Mismi and in Rabana, it was decided that AMCLATTER-1 may be taking a bit of adventage of the Station in asking for exchange of the additional \$15,000, \$12,000 of which is his own money and \$3,000 is from his mother-in-law. In view of AMIATER-1's excellent record with the organization and his present tense financial situation, it was agreed that some effort should be made to help him in the matter. Accordingly, after a short meeting in Mismi with AMMIATURE-1, Reichborth and Esterline agreed to cable the Station, bringing them up-to-date on the matter.

- 2. There appeared to be some misunderstanding between Headquarters and inishbardt with regard to whether AMIATER-1 -- who is a stateless person at the present time-should leave the country for much a place as Hassau and reenter the States with proper dominentation. After it was explained to Reichbertt that Resignarters has an obligation to Emigration in this matter, he agreed to instruct AMIATIMA-1 to proceed to Massem in the next few days and get his peners in order. Attlational, in a mosting with Esterline, agreed to do this.
- J. It became very apparent during the moeting with AMCLATTER-1 that he still is must anxious to work with the organization. Esterline received an expellent impression of the man, his motivation, his drive, and his present need in view of the hardskips he has suffered. AkilATTER-1 was therefore told that some occasideration would be given to finding employment for him on his return if he was successful in clarifying his status in the States.
