1. Reference is made to your memorandum of 2 December 1954, your file number 2-1396, concerning subject; to our communication dated 22 November 1954, entitled John D. McCORMICK, also known as Edward BROWDER, Jr., Edward Browder SABATINO, Eduardo SABATINO, Edward Sabatino OLLIVIER, cut number 92570; and to previous correspondence concerning subject.

2. Attached for your retention are photostatic copies of the following documents which were furnished by a usually reliable source, who received them from a person of unknown reliability, in September 1954:

- a. An agreement dated 29 November 1953, by which Eduardo SABATINO agreed to sell certain arms and aircraft valued at \$250,000 (U.S.) to Major Jose Eduardo MONTEVIDEO Penagos, an exiled Guatemalan Army officer. (As of May 1954 MONTEVIDEO was in a Mexico City jail for failure to pay a hotel bill.)
- b. A letter, or note, dated 30 June 1954 from Eduardo SABATINO II, to Robert ALVARADO Puentes, for the Guatemalan Ambassador to Mexico. There is no indication that this letter was mailed.
- c. A letter dated 22 March 1953 from the Chief of Police, Miami Shores Village, Florida, stating that Edward BROWDER, Jr., a resident of Miami Shores Village, is a low ranking citizen of that town.
- d. A letter dated 3 August 1954 from Edward BROWDER, Jr., to Col. Marcos RIZAL Jimenez, President of Venezuela. There is no indication this letter was mailed.

- e. A letter dated 3 August 1954 from Edward BREWER to General Fulgencio BATISTA, of Cuba. There is no indication that this letter was mailed.
- f. An undated letter (probably July 1954) from Edwards SABATINO to an unnamed ambassador, possibly the Nicaraguan Ambassador to Mexico.
- g. A letter dated 1 August 1954 from Edward Brewster SABATINO to General A. SNOZA, of Nicaragua.
- h. This document appears to be part of an agreement whereby subject will operate in Europe on behalf of an un-named government.
- i. This document appears to contain call letters for radio stations and cryptic symbols for certain countries.
- j. This document contains rough drawings of bombs and grenades.
- k. A letter signed Edwards and dated 30 July (1954) at Guatemala City. It appears from this letter that subject may have gone to Guatemala City after his escape on 26 June 1954 from the custody of Mexican Immigration authorities.
- l. The documents listed above were made available to the Legal Attaché and to the American Embassy in Mexico City.
