1. After receipt of reference A, NYLILY-1 was picked up by the Panama Station on 16 December 1961 for joint KUNPE/KUCAGE use. Since that time, NYLILY-1 has prepared 10 reports on individuals of interest to the Station and has provided coverage of the activities of the Cuban groups in Panama.

2. Upon receipt of reference B, NYLILY-1 was assigned to arrange the requested coverage of the visit of Dr. Luis CONTE Aguirre. Dr. CONTE arrived at Tocumen airport at 10:40 P.M., on 2 JANUARY 1962 and departed for Caracas at 11:20 P.M. the same night. NYLILY-1 arranged the following coverage:

- a. A reception by approximately 35 Cuban exiles  
b. A 10 minute interview on RPC television, broadcast 3 January 1962  
c. A 15 minute taped interview on Radio Cadena Universal  
d. A photograph and accompanying article published in "La Estrella de Panama" (clippings were pouches literally to reference B addressees)  
e. A photograph and accompanying article published in "Critica"

3. The Station is aware of NYLILY-1's duties as the local AMRND representative and foresees no conflict of interest or unnecessary duplication of efforts at present. In coordination and with support of the Station, NYLILY-1 has organized the five minute work stoppage in support of the OAS and action against CASINO. In addition, subject has written and arranged placements of both a full-page and a one-third page articles in each of several local newspapers. These articles will appear on 22 January and will urge OAS action against the communist government of Cuba.
