CONCLUSIONS

A member of a group of Cuban emigres trained in the techniques of information collection. The group has provided useful reports for over two years. This information was obtained from Dr. Marcos Rodriguez Menendez.

1. As of early July 1953, according to Dr. Marcos Rodriguez Hernandez, an attorney and executive member of the Movimiento Democrata Cristiano (MDC, Christian Democrat Movement), the MDC had made a unity pact with Comandos L, a Cuban exile organization lead by Antonio Cuesta del Valle. According to the terms of the pact, the Comandos L were to contribute training and assistance in military intelligence and were to provide three naval units and one B-26 aircraft which the group already had in its possession. The MDC was to contribute three small boats and a team of men to be infiltrated into Cuba.
2. The MDC was also involved in unity negotiations with Dr. Carlos Prío Socarrás who would contribute \$50,000.00 exclusively for military aid this was not to be used for bureaucratic affairs. The MDC would contribute men and the name of the organization to the operation or operations and would provide political support to Prío.
3. The MDC was also negotiating a unity pact for action with the Directorio Revolucionario Estudiantil (DRE, Students' Revolutionary Directorate).
4. Rodriguez said that the negotiations with the Movimiento de Recuperación Revolucionaria (MRR, Movement for Revolutionary Recovery) had proved unsuccessful. Dr. Manuel Artime Buena did not appear to be in favor of unity with the MDC.

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5. The MDC planned to buy a new boat with which to engage in an unspecified action on the Cuban coast, but the execution of this plan depended on the financial assistance which the organization expected to receive from Pyle.
6. The MDC planned to stage another air raid against the Belot oil refinery in the city of Habana, this time using an aircraft especially prepared for the raid and with adequate bombs to destroy the target. The group wanted to prevent a repetition of what happened during the last raid.

7. Field Comment: The same subsource reported in CSDB-7655,718, dated 26 July 1963, that Laureano Batista Falla was believed to be making preparations for his plan to bomb the oil refineries in Regla, Habana Province, in the near future with a B-28 aircraft which the MDC had in its possession as of 1 July.

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
