For some months <sup>16-8</sup> [the Station] has successfully intercepted George de MOHRENSCHILDT's personal mail, securely monitoring those letters indicated in DIR-41342, DIR-81595, and DIR-82820.</p> <p>2. The original purpose for intercepting DE MOHRENSCHILDT's <sup>16-8</sup> mail was to tell us Subject's correspondents outside Haiti. Today [the Station] has such an excellent list of names and addresses of Subject's worldwide acquaintances that current incoming letters almost always bear the same addresses previously reported.</p> <p>3. <sup>16-8</sup> [The Station] would like to know <sup>16-8</sup> if Headquarters has a continued interest in all of Subject's mail. If not, [the Station] will discontinue reporting previously reported addresses and will continue to monitor those letters from individuals noted in DIR cables mentioned in paragraph one above.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>William S.
