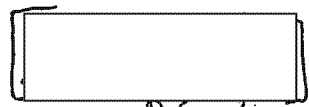
1. As indicated in a telephone conversation this date between the writer and Miss Martha Tharpe, WH/3/AO, the Commissioner of the Immigration and Naturalization Service has requested that he be informed prior to any publication of the fact that the subject is in the United States. The Commissioner made this request in order that he can be prepared to answer any possible inquiries directed to him as to the manner in which the subject gained access to the United States.

2. In order to satisfy the request of General Swing, it is requested that this Office be informed in advance of any surfacing of the subject in order that appropriate information can be related to the Commissioner.
