SUBJECT: Contact With Sr. Manuel Antonio DB VARONA 11 July 1961

- 1. In response to a call to Bender from VARCHA, the undersigned called VARCHA 11 July 1951 at the Roosevelt Hotel, Mashington, D.C., Room 707, and in the course of the conversation VARCHA brought up the following points:
 - a. The problem of the magistrates.
 - . The problem of IHIGOTAN.
 - c. The problem of three of the prisoners from the invasion force who are in the United States in commection with the tractor negotiations and who, Sr. VARONA stated, are "stranded" at the Harriott Motel. VARONA would like \$1,000.00-\$1,500.00 to send these three men to New York and back to Hismi in connection with their efforts.

2. VAROWA also referred to a plan to send three Gubans, including a labor leader, on an anti-CASTRO mission to Latin America at a cost of about \$6,500.00 for each person. He also referred to the reported tramises of support for himself and his family, referring and "Bender" as those who had guaranteed the claused supports.

3. VARCHA's approach on the matters of the magistrates and IRIGHTM was the same as that taken by MIRO.

h. Either through ARAIGE or MIRO, or both, 71RONA knows of a contact between the undersigned as Raymond S. Clark and MIRO and ARAIGN.
