1. Reference is made to your memorandum dated 21 August 1961, FBI File #100-37543, in which you request any information concerning the activities abroad of David G. KACINEZ. Our representatives in Cairo have learned that he is currently employed by the Middle East Features in Cairo and that he applied for a Saudi Arabian visa to cover the Arab League Conference in Riyadh for American, British, and French clients.

2. According to a later report, Subject's assignment was cancelled, possibly because of failure to obtain the visa.
