1. When "Al Grupo" arrives in Mexico its first problem will be to set up, as soon as possible, a daily nowspaper and a press relations office.

- 2. To succeed the Grupo will need the assistance of Station Harico in improving the public and political climate in which anti-CASTRO people can work effectively.
- 3. A tremendous publicity drive should be made on the arrival of "El Grupo" in Mexico in order to create the proper image of the PRD in Vexico and throughout Latin America.
- A. It is hoped that Mr. Hunt and the Station officers will be able to support and guide AMJIA, who will be producing "El Mundo in Exile", which will ostensibly be independent but actually will be a pro-FRD newspaper. AMJIA will also be making satirical, humorous radio tapes for broadcasting over Radio Sman. Any help that can be given to this endeavor will be greatly approciated.
