1. POTENTIAL ALIEN VIOLATORS INSIDE AND OUTSIDE THE UNITED STATES

*etA Request*

An item in the Citizen of Jan. 2 reads. "TOP SOVIET FUGITIVE IN CANADA? LONDON(CP) Anatoli Dolnytsin, one of the most important fugitives from Soviet Russia, is reported to be living in Canada.

"The Daily Telegraph says he went to Canada some weeks ago "with his appearance altered." It adds that Dolnytsin is living "in the same province" - it does not say which one-as Igor Gouzenko; key figure in Canada's espionage case of 1946.

"In Ottawa, officials of the RCMP and the External Affairs Department said they have no knowledge that Dolnytsin is in Canada."
