was obviously referring to the name Aulabia used prior to coming to Helsinki. tity 4. De never referred to the name that atharis used officially in Helsind. Collide only commented that he did not know anyone in Felsinki 4 with a name similar to CHAMSIN. The conversation continued in general terms about wemmark, the Danish language, and sports. ICPACY brought up the last subject and asked if COTILLE participated in any aparts. COTILLE mentioned both tennis and squash. Link V expressed an interest in squash and said he had never heard of the game before. Le asked if Costille would be willing to teach him to play. In Times answered in the affirmative, and LCBANCY_ said he would telephone confirm during the following week. LOBARY I then offered COUTILE some food, excused himself. and joined another group of people. CCCTILLE did not talk to .ICDAICY I again except up to COSTILLE near the end of the party when COSTILLS was talking to identity ? LIPSKIN sahortly left, and ICEAROUS to make the cost in t to thank the latter for the party and to say goodbye. ICRANOV's a wife came LIFEKIT schoolly left, and LUSANOV's's wife and COSTILLE continued talking for about 20 minutes. She looks to be in her late twenties, is quite attractive and was nicely dresped. She is a little sky but is quite well poised and does not seem ill at ease in talking with westerners. She also made a good impression on the others present, including the wives. She will obviously be an asset to LOBANCV I in his diplomatic career. She speaks some English, but her vocabulary is quite limited. She seems to be fairly well educated, and she referred once or twice to "the institute in Moscow" which she had attended. The said she was born in the north Caucasus. Politics were not discussed at all. She made no derogatory comments about their last post in I Oslo , nor about Demmark or toe United States. She said she liked living in Oslo ; and thought it a beautiful country.

We do not know LOBANOV's a motive in tringing up A LADLE's name. COSTILLE and LOBANCV . were standing alone at the time but the room was crowded and several groups of people sere talking nearby. I LORANOV's question about Allalia was very matter-of-fact, and he did not lower his voice or ask the question in a furtive manner. However, the room was fairly noisy, and LOBANOV would have probably realised that the conversation could not be overheard. It is somewhat strange he referred to AHLADLE by "GOLUBISING 6 name rather than the actual mame A LADL's used in Helsinki. If LOBANOV had mentioned the name AcidDic used in Helsinkii. COSTILLE would have probably admitted knowing AllADLA. To have done otherwise would have been an obvious lis. we can only guess at this stage of the contact that I LOBANOV was simply interested in finding out what happened to AELADLE. It would seem logical that LOBANOV had known previously that CONTILLE has had some contact with AELADLE in Helsinki. Ferhaps LORANOV's's motive will become evident in subsequent contacts. As of this writing he has not attempted to recontact CONTILLE. We will keep Headquarters informed.
