SUBJECT: AKLADLE/Operations  
Request for AKLADLE-ROODIKE Meeting

ACTION REQUIRED REFERENCES

Action: See Para 2

1. In line with talks I had at Headquarters on AKLADLE and what he knows about KGB operations in Finland, I am writing to ask permission to go to London sometime in July or August to talk to AKLADLE for a period of about a week. There are many items still unclarified and I think that, because of our past association, AKLADLE will agree to meet and talk. Some of the points I would like to cover are:

- a. A rundown on the KGB and GRU officers known to AKLADLE who are still in Finland.
- b. A check through the names and pictures of new arrivals, in the hopes of identifying KGB and GRU replacements.
- c. Debriefing on non-SIE Soviets who might be susceptible to approaches.
- d. Thorough debriefing on Yuriy VORONIN (201-92927), including AKLADLE's ideas on how he might best be approached (although we also have our own ideas on this subject).
- e. Debriefing on K. O. VIITANEN (201-211177), by request of [VALI<sup>02</sup>ST/2].
- f. Re-examination of the charges AKLADLE brought against: Kustaa VILKKA (201-113484)
- g. Clarification of minor points [VALI<sup>01</sup>ST/6] and [VALI<sup>02</sup>ST/2] have brought up.

In addition to the names and pictures of new Soviets mentioned above, I intend to bring to this meeting the architect's building plans of the Soviet Embassy which we recently received from [VALI<sup>01</sup>ST/6] (see OPIA-6177) for use in the debriefing of him on the location of the KGB and GRU offices and who occupied which office.
