<p>On 1 December ^{DI} [VAI/IN/6] said that Soviet Consul Golub had told ^{DI} [VAI/IN/1] that a western agent, who crossed the Finnish-Soviet border near Imatra on 18 May 1959 had been arrested and was being held by the Soviets. Golub did not reveal the name of the agent, but said that he had been trained in Austria. To the Station's knowledge, there have been no REDFOX missions run via Finland by KUBARK since 1953. Does Headquarters know of any REDFOX agents who disappeared in May? Or is Golub making up the story?</p> <p style="text-align: right;">Oliver P.
