The newspaper picture of Subject submitted with reference was shown to AKD/PPNR/20 who said that OOLUB's face was familiar to him, and when the name was furnished Source stated there was a Lt. Colonel of this last name in the MGB. Source did not know which directorate Lt. Col. OOLUB was in - might be the technical section - but he knew that OOLUB was a "fairly high boss." Source could not recall whether he had ever seen Subject so does not know if the OOLUB in the newspaper picture is one and the same with Lt. Col. OOLUB of the MGB.
