| <p>1. In accordance with a policy decision to keep BKHERALD contact with U. S. business representatives discreet, a small luncheon was held in lieu of the customary formal briefings in the Headquarters building. <b>KDACETONE-1</b>, <b>IDENTITY 1</b>, David C.
