In a memorandum dated 29 February 1960 ODENVI reported that on 17 February an informant who has furnished reliable information in the past advised that on the previous day he had observed William Alexander MORGAN in Toledo, Ohio, in the company of Roberto Augustus PRONN, Jr., Toledo Police Department Number 36131. The source did not know how long MORGAN had been in Toledo, where he was staying, what he was doing, or how long he planned to stay.

2. ODENVI would appreciate receiving any data concerning MORGAN's entry into the United States and the purpose of his trip. It is requested that Station Habana forward to Headquarters any information available on MORGAN's current activities, including any indication he recently made a trip to the United States, for passage to ODENVI.
