RECE HAD BEEN APPROACHED BY CARABALLO (FNU) FOR FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR AN OPERATION INVOLVING THE BLOWING UP OF A SOVIET OR CUBAN VESSEL IN VERACRUZ, MEXICO.
