Memorandum from C/wli/4/PA dated 10 January 1961

- 1. Transmitted herewith in accordance with the request contained in the reference is the Cuban passport of Panuel Antiono RAY Rivera, with the period of validity extended to 19 December 1963.
- 2. While it has been TSD/IB's observation that Cubar passports are not normally extended more than eight years beyond the date of original issue, it is felt that there should be no difficulty in using the passport for normal international travel outside Cuba.
- 3. Also inserted in the passport per telephone request from WAVE relayed through [Fig. Stanley Shultz] a TSD/IB document analyst presently on TDY there, is a U.S. visa (issued in Santiago de Cuba dated 20 October 1960, and valid for four years.

4. It is our understanding that IENS at Missi will enter the necessary U.S. "ADMITTED" cachet.
