MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

SUBJECT: Information from [redacted] in Answer to Question Re Identity of American who Allegedly Paid Manuel RAY's Fine in Nassau

1. [redacted] called at 1745/12 June 1964 to say that the [redacted] had replied to our query as to the identity of the American who allegedly paid Manuel RAY's fine in Nassau (see TIME of 12 June 1964, page 48). The [redacted] stated that he saw no such figure and to the best of his knowledge there was no such person. The [redacted] also stated that he was discreetly checking as to whom Manuel RAY called in Miami from Nassau. The [redacted] will let us know the results of the check.
2. [redacted] of course did not tell [redacted] that we know the identity of the American as reported to us by Rogelio CISNEROS of JURE.
