SUBJECT

- 1. Midmirit was the life President Csarnikow-Rionda Company, 106 Wall Every twee Rock Now York, on 13 August 1963 notified a representative of this Agency that he had recently received a telephone call from Asxander E-RORKE. In the telephone conversation RORKE indicated he and his friends, Frank Anthony STURGIS and Oscar MESTRE Mascaro, were all set to do "something"; they had an aircraft of undisclosed type, and needed a boat. According to MALONE, RORKE seemed to be fishing for an indication as to whether MALONE's principals would give any monetary support to RORKE's activities. MALONE told our representative he could probably get additional details about RORKE's activities if this Agency so desired.
- 2. The representative of this Agency reminded MALONE that the activities of RORKE were of primary concern to the Federal Bureau of Investigation, and that this Agency would report this information to the Bureau.
- 3. This information is being forwarded in the event the Bureau may wish to ask MALONE for further information. MALONE, RORKE, STURGIS, and MESTRE have all been the subject of previous correspondence between this Agency and the Bureau.
