1. AVEB-1 (Identity under separate cover), a staybehind principal agent of the Habana Station, has been assigned the post office box listed in (RVC) 559. He has also been trained in a CW system and will use the (Caracas) P.O. box to send CW messages in the event staybehind activities become necessary in Cuba. 16-17
2. It is currently contemplated that when a message containing CW is received at the (Caracas) post office box, it will be developed by (Caracas) Station and the contents relayed to Headquarters by cable for the preparation of a reply if one is necessary. The reply will either be pouched or cabled to (Caracas) for sending on to AVEB-1 in Cuba. 16-17
3. It is requested that (the Caracas Station) advise the Habana Station of the return address which will be used in forwarding CW letters to AVEB-1. 01
4. You will be advised of the post office box of AVEB-1 at a later date. 01
