SUBJECT : Request for Cover for ~~MIKE-1~~<sup>MIKE-1</sup>

1. It is requested that OCD provide cover for ~~MIKE-1~~<sup>MIKE-1</sup>, who is a contract agent, operating in the Miami, Florida, area. The cover required is not for operational purposes but merely to provide him with a suitable backstop to enable him to establish credit, purchase an automobile and house, and to cover other normal activities; in effect, cover for status rather than cover for action. The following information is keyed to the format provided in the memorandum entitled "Non-Official Cover Request for Individual."

A. General Information on Agent

- (1) This is the initial request for cover for Subject.
- (2) Contract agent, salary \$9,600 per annum. No allowances.
- (3) OA granted 30 June 1960. Subject has been granted a Type A clearance pending a favorable LCP/ITER. His wife is aware of his U.S. Government affiliation but not knowledgeable of his association with the Agency.
- (4) Agent is not going overseas.
- (5) Subject has not been subjected to psychological assessment and the carriage test.
- (6) No previous cover employed by Subject.
- (7) Subject is presently in Miami and is in urgent need of cover.

He was granted a FOI on 4 April 1960 [redacted] and an CI on 30 June 1960, for use as a principal agent in a Habana Intelligence net. Pending a favorable LCFI/STEL, Subject has been granted a Type A clearance and will be permitted to have access to Agency buildings as well as Top Secret information. No derogatory information has been developed by Security in investigations.
- (2) Subject is aware of the Agency's interest.

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- (3) Subject has never entered the Agency's installations at Headquarters.
- (4) Subject will be in contact with other contract agents in the Miami area.
- (5) Subject has not been associated with nor identified to any foreign or domestic intelligence, police or security service.
