RE SLOBODA CASE. WHILE IN LONDON MR. [redacted] ⁰⁶ DISCUSSED CASE WITH
[OUR STATION THERE] ¹⁵⁻¹ AND WAS AGAIN TOLD THAT [redacted] ²⁴ ASSISTANCE CANNOT
BE EXPECTED UNLESS ADDITIONAL REASONS THAN THOSE STATED IN ATTACHMENTS
TO YOUR LETTER TO BSSO, DATED 11 SEPTEMBER 1960, ARE SUBMITTED.
THEREFORE REQUEST TO KNOW WHETHER [redacted] ²⁴ AUTHORIZED TRANSMIT
YOUR LETTER OF 30 SEPTEMBER 1960 AND ATTACHMENTS TO ITS [LONDON STATION] ¹⁵⁻¹
AND HAVE LATTER USE SUBSTANCE PARAS 3 AND 4 OF THIS LETTER AS BASIS
FOR RENEWING REQUEST FOR [redacted] ²⁴ ASSISTANCE.

Above sent via UACME TTY to Camp King on 7 October 1960. Col. Ross called
me at 1100 hours 7 October 1960 and agreed to forwarding of above correspondence
to [London Station] ¹⁵⁻¹ provided his letter to us would not be released to [redacted] ²⁴
in original form.
