<p>1. ANWHIP/2 telephoned Bance on 12 November 1965 and announced his presence in Rome. A luncheon date was set for 17 November, when the following information was obtained.</p> <p>2. Asked about Max INTRATOR (201-3001/3), ANWHIP/2 said that he is still barred from entering France or England but that through the intercession of the Swiss Ambassador in Cuba the ban on his entering Switzerland has been lifted. Asked about INTRATOR's current income or financial standing, ANWHIP/2 said that he does fairly well but does not enjoy a large income. He added that Ambassador Antonio Maria GARRILLO Carreras (201-349956) had told him that the Cuban regime does not trust INTRATOR but needs him. His function is to arrange for the purchase by the regime of manufacturing plants which can be transported to Cuba in toto and there assembled. He buys for goods rather than cash.</p> <p>3. ANWHIP/1 and ANWHIP/2 were together in Paris on 13 October 1965 (and presumably for a few days before and/or after this date). While there they saw CAERILLO, from whom they purchased \$12,000 worth of jewelry, almost all of it junk.</p> <p>4. In Paris on 13 October ANWHIP/1 and ANWHIP/2 met the man IGLESIAS who appears in (OIRA) 37855, 7 August 1964, as a jeweler trusted by the regime and used by it as an assassin. ANWHIP/2 says that IGLESIAS, formerly the owner of the largest jewelry store in Havana, is an upright business man. ^(P-9) Comment: ANWHIP/2 can never recall IGLESIAS' first name. Identification by Headquarters or JMWAVE would be helpful.) IGLESIAS made the following statement about the heirlooms shipment:</p> <p>²² NOWZALEDEH was accompanied ²³ to Havana by Tommaso FATTORINI. (See (OIRA) 41855, 7 August 1964; (OIRAD) 3614, 10 November 1964, not to JMWAVE or Milan Basin; (OIRAD) 4240, 3 December 1964; (OIRAD) 4185, 27 January 1965; and (OIRAD) 1732, 7 April 1965.) Florence dealer in art, jews, etc., and other valuations, the amount
exchanged with Celia SANCHEZ being approximately \$10,000.
Amount in cash where AMWHIP/2 paid the equivalent for \$10,000,
plus \$1,000 for parking and freight. Includes in this purchase were
silver and rugs. The rugs wound up in France.

4. As was previously reported, the mother of the wife of
AMWHIP/2 is dying of cancer in Cuba and has not (according to
Cuban medical reports received by the wife) a real coal of time
left. Therefore the wife plans to go to Cuba in January 1962 to
see her. Ambassador CAPILLIO has offered to accompany the wife to
Havana and back and guarantees her safe return. AMWHIP/2 is a
trifle dubious about the plan but is inclined to think that the risk
is minimal. [] Comment: He has asked for our views. Head-
quarters comments are requested.)

5. AMWHIP/2 next spoke of Celia SANCHEZ. Comment:
Although Celia SANCHEZ does not appear in the Agency Index or Watch
List, there have been frequent references to her in [] (APOGEO) and
other traffic. She seems to be a girl Friday to Fidel CASTRO, a
person of great importance in the GOC, whose orders are accepted
by GOC representatives abroad much as though they came from Fidel
himself.) AMWHIP/2 says that Celia SANCHEZ has in Havana a sister
whose name he cannot remember, who is an inspector of schools, but
whose influence in the regime is greater than her position would
suggest. The sister has a husband of whose name AMWHIP/2 is
uncertain; he thinks it might be J. SANCHEZ Portella. AMWHIP/2
said that the husband is also a person of considerable influence
and that those seeking favors or help in matters in which they
cannot turn directly to Fidel or Celia SANCHEZ address their
requests to the sister's husband. AMWHIP/2 intends to instruct
his wife to look up the husband while she is in Cuba, both as a
possible further guarantee of her safety and as a means of getting
further information about him.

7. It was suggested to AMWHIP/2 that if his wife makes the
trip she might also look up Comandante Juan ALMEIDA Roque (201..
224327). [] Comment: Buc WAVE-4021, 30 October 1961, noted
[] (Frankfurt) Germany or [] Headquarters will recall
that both the wife of AMWHIP/2 and ALMEIDA are mulattoes (ALMEIDA
is quite dark-skinned) and have been friends in the past (when
ALMEIDA got the brother of AMWHIP/2's wife out of jail). WAVE-4021
suggested the possibility that ALMEIDA might visit AMWHIP/2 and
his wife in Switzerland. It was therefore suggested to AMWHIP/2 that
his wife might not only have a friendly chat with ALMEIDA but might
also extend an invitation for such a visit, which has not materialized
to date. [] Comment: Although the chances are against
an acceptance of such an invitation, the chance to associate AMWHIP/2 with
a prominent Vice Minister of the Cuban Armed Forces is a strongly
one which is not to be overlooked.
